**This Board concerns itself with the protection of life and property from fire and for the conservation of natural and human resources. The Board assures proper control and administration of the property, debts, and assets of the district.**

**The Board of Fire Commissioners, who shall be appointed by the Commissioners Court, shall be the governing body of the district. They shall serve for a term of two years and until their successors are appointed and qualified.**

**Board Members serve a two year staggered term. Two board positions expire in January of even-numbered years and three board positions expire in January of odd-numbered years.**
