

JUSTICE COURTS  
PROPER ATTIRE  
(DRESS CODE)

PROPER ATTIRE IS REQUIRED OF EVERYONE ENTERING A COURTROOM. CLOTHING MUST BE CLEAN AND PROPERLY WORN. THE FOLLOWING ARE SPECIFIC ITEMS THAT DO NOT MEET THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR PROPER COURTROOM ATTIRE:

**NO SHORTS**

**NO TANKTOPS**

**NO HALTERTOPS**

**NO SKIRTS THAT DO NOT EXTEND TO AT LEAST THE MIDDLE OF THE THIGH WHILE SITTING**

**NO EXPOSED UNDERWARE**

**NO SLACKS, TROUSERS, OR JEANS THAT CAN ONLY BE SUPPORTED BY THE WEARER'S HANDS**

**NO BARE FEET OR "FLIP FLOPS"**

**NO OFFENSIVE, VIOLENT, OBSCENE OR SUGGESTIVE SLOGANS OR CARICATURES SHALL BE DISPLAYED ON CLOTHING**

**NO CHEWING GUM OR BUBBLE GUM**

ANYONE NOT PROPERLY DRESSED UPON ARRIVING IN THE COURTROOM MAY BE SENT AWAY UNTIL PROPERLY DRESSED OR MAY BE FOUND IN CONTEMPT OF COURT AND SUBJECT TO A FINE OR INCARCERATION OR BOTH.
