LCS Corrections Services, Inc. The owner and operator of the new Coastal Bend Correctional Center in Robstown recently announced its initiative regarding the blockages in the Petronila Creek.

Spokesperson Richard Harbison, Vice President of LCS provided the following information after personally reviewing the site.

With input from and in cooperation with Robstown Mayor Ramon, State Representative Herrero, County Judge Neal, Commissioner Longoria and interested residents, LCS has devised a plan at its own expense to provide heavy equipment and personnel to clear four (4) major blockages in Petronila Creek. These blockages consist of old boats, cars, appliances and other various debris, which all disrupt the water flow.

While LCS is aware that its Correctional Center will have no effect upon the creek or its water, it is clearly apparent that the blockages are an eyesore, could be hazardous, and definitely disrupt the water flow periodically.

LCS is conducting this effort as a community service project and wishes to thank all who participated with their support and information.

The meeting and escorted tour of the site will begin on Monday, July 7th, at 10:30 a.m. at the facility (CR 34 west of US 77).
