**TxDmv plans to install the new equipment on Monday, February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2012.**


To help the TxDMV with its installation, the Nueces County Tax Office Substations will be closed as follows:

**Robstown office will be closed all day, February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2012.**

**Bishop & Port Aransas offices will remain open on February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2012 but all motor vehicle transactions will be offline for the day. Collection of property taxes will still be available.**

We want to urge our customers to please come in before the installation begins to conduct any urgent business they may have. The Nueces County Tax Office and the TxDMV do not want any customers to face late penalties.
