NUECES COUNTY VETERANS' ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM

Nueces County has received a grant from the Texas Veterans Commission Fund for Veterans' Assistance.

The program provides emergency financial assistance to eligible Nueces County veterans, their dependents, and surviving spouses.



Eligibility guidelines have been established using specific income brackets and other criteria to determine the need for emergency assistance.

Emergency assistance includes basic life needs such as mortgage/rent, utilities (water, gas, electricity), food, and transportation.

The purpose of the Nueces County Veterans' Assistance Grant Program is to satisfy the unmet, emergency financial needs of Nueces County veterans, their families, and veterans' surviving spouses. It is not an entitlement program based on veteran status.

Please note that is program is grant-funded and subject to the availability of funds.

APPLICATION PROCESS

To apply, please visit the Nueces County Department of Veterans Services at the following address:

Initial eligibility will be determined at the Veterans Services office. If you meet the minimum eligibility requirements, you will then be referred for final determination of eligibility.

Final eligibility is determined by the Nueces County Department of Human Services located on the 3rd floor of the Nueces County Courthouse, Room 302.

Please bring the following items with you:

- ◆ Copy of your DD214, showing an Honorable Discharge (not related to misconduct)
- ◆ Valid picture identification such as Driver's License, State Issued I.D. or Military I.D.
- ◆ Social Security Card
- ◆ Current mortgage statement, rent receipts or copy of lease agreement
- ◆ Current utility bills
- ◆ Voter registration (to prove Nueces County residency)
- ◆ Proof of income for the past 30 days for all household members, including but not limited to check stubs, letter from employer, Social Security, SSI and VA, unemployment or worker's compensation, etc.
- ◆ Proof of work search for all employable members of household (if unemployed)

- ◆ If disabled and under doctor's care, you must provide a current medical report.
- ◆ If your household is eligible for TANF benefits, you must provide proof of application.
- ◆ If applying for food assistance, you must provide proof of pending food stamp application.

Other information may be requested.
