

WORKSHOP ANNOUNCEMENT

Nueces County Sheriff's Office is offering a 4 hour workshop on "Pursuit Policy," specifically developed for law enforcement officers. The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration is partnering with IADLEST, the International Association of Directors of Law Enforcement Standards, and ALERT International, the Association of Law Enforcement Emergency Response Trainers, to present information consistent with the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP) pursuit policy guidelines.

The workshop is scheduled for March 3, 2010, from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at the Del Mar College West Campus-Emerging Technology Building Room 124 at 4101 Old Brownsville Road, Corpus Christi, Texas.

The Pursuit Policy Workshop is designated to provide guidance for the officer from the initiation of the vehicle pursuit through its conclusion. Individual agency policies will be discussed along with the IACP pursuit policy guidelines. The workshop will provide law enforcement officers with the knowledge necessary to safely and successfully conduct vehicle pursuits.

This half-day workshop will:

- Discuss U.S. Supreme Court decisions and State specific statutes that have impacted and governed vehicular pursuit operations
- Discuss the components of the IACP vehicular pursuit policy guide
- Compare your agency's current policy with the IACP vehicular pursuit guidelines
- Develop an action plan for your agency that supports vehicular pursuit operations and addresses any weak or missing areas within the current pursuit policy

There is no fee to attend the workshop. Please bring a current copy of your Agency's pursuit policy.
